GEOSCIENCE AUSTRALIA EXCURSION - YEAR 8

DESCRIPTION:

As part of our Term 2 school wide Global Concept: *Environmental Stewardship*, Year 8 learners will be participating in a variety of activities to enhance their understanding of the various ways we can learn about the environment, both locally and universally. We will be exposing learners to a range of professionals and experts through the following excursions and incursions over the coming weeks. The program will include 2 excursions offsite as well as two presentations at Evelyn Scott School by subject matter experts.:

Excursion 1: Geoscience Australia Education Centre - Thursday 13 June 2024

Year 8 learners will visit Geoscience Australia Education Centre for a 90 minute educational presentation which offers curriculum-linked education programs designed to immerse students in hands-on geoscientific activities. Learners will investigate rocks and minerals through a program that focuses on identifying rocks through their characteristics. They will inspect the different properties, such as lustre, hardness and streak, which help geologists identify minerals.
